Dear Year 11 Student,

Results Day: Thursday 20th August 2020

I hope you and your families are keeping safe and well. I write to let you know how we are following the Government's social distancing guidelines to plan your Results Day on Thursday 20 August. We will ensure that you receive your results safely and have access to the necessary guidance and support to inform your plans Post 16.

Firstly, we have staggered the times we are asking students to come in to school in order to limit the number of people on site at any one time. You will only be allowed to access the site via the main gate near Reception, where hand sanitiser will be available, and will be asked to line up on arrival observing social distancing. Please do not arrive more than five minutes before your time slot, allocated according to the initial (and second letter) of your surname, as below:

We are implementing the following safety measures once you have entered through the main gate:

- a one-way system from the main gate to the PA where you will collect your results and speak to staff should you have any queries or questions about your results followed by exit via the back door of the PA and then the gate near the bike sheds;
- hand sanitiser upon your arrival as well as in PA;
- separated results collection and guidance tables in PA, observing social distancing guidelines;
- staff handling your results envelope will be wearing disposable gloves.

Please do ensure you stay at least 1 metre apart from others during your time on site.

Ernulf Academy staff will be on hand at school on Results Day to offer advice and guidance should you wish to reconsider your Post 16 plans once you have received your results. Miss Webber, via Brogan.webber@astreaernulf.org will be your main contact should you need support at other times.

Astrea Sixth Form St Neots staff will be offering remote support on Results Day. You are asked to email info@astreasixthformstneots.org with any queries. (If you have applied to Astrea Sixth Form St Neots you will also shortly receive information and guidance in preparation for the new term.)

Cambridge Regional College is offering online Zoom sessions (from Results Day to 4 September) plus on-campus drop-ins at both Huntingdon and Cambridge campuses between these dates; please see the enclosed CRC "Advice Cafés" flier for further information. We will let you have any information from other providers as it becomes available and on the day.

Please check the school website regularly for any updates from the exam board, Ofqual or JCQ.

Finally, if for any reason you will not be collecting your results in person, please note the following:

- If a friend or relative is able to collect your results for you, we will require them to bring a signed written permission note from you, giving them permission to collect your results on your behalf. Results must be collected at the time, according to the initial (and second letter) of your surname, as detailed in the table above. Please email me at Alison.Black@astreaernulf.org to let me know you are arranging this and who you are authorising to collect your results.
- Results may be emailed to you after 11:00 on Results Day if you are unable to collect them. Please email me at Alison.Black@astreaernulf.org to let me have the email address to be used for this purpose.
