Dear Parent/Carer,

End of Year Reward Trip

After what has been a demanding year for all of our pupils, we would like to reward each and every pupil for their hard work and resilience. We will be offering a school visit to Thorpe Park Resort in Surrey for Year 7 and Year 8 pupils on Tuesday 13th July. A duplicate visit will take place on Thursday 15th July for pupils in Year 9 and Year 10.

The total cost of the trip including return coach travel and entry into Thorpe Park will be £35. In order to secure a place on the trip, we would ask that you pay the total amount of £35 before Friday 25th June. A provisional place has been reserved for all pupils, however, any pupil not wishing to go will be able to remain in school for the day and appropriate learning activities will be provided. We kindly ask that payments for the trip are completed using ParentPay so that we can continue to adhere to the COVID-19 guidance by not accepting cash.

Over the past week, pupils have had tutor time and assemblies to inform them that their continued hard work and contributions to lessons will enable them to earn merits.

50 merits = £2.50 reward
100 merits = £5.00 reward
150 merits = £10.00 reward
200 merits = £20.00 reward

The period for which merits can be earned is from Monday 12th April until Friday 9th July. Any reward your child earns will be posted out to you in the form of a voucher before the end of the academic term on Friday 16th July.

Finally, may I remind you, that participation in this trip is a reward and a privilege and we can only take pupils who can be trusted to behave appropriately and uphold Ernulf Academy standards. If any pupil does not uphold these standards, we reserve the right to withdraw the pupil and return any money paid for a place on the trip. We are planning the trip in line with up-to-date government guidance, but should local restrictions come into force immediately prior to the trip then we will inform parents and carers immediately and ensure that a full refund is provided.
