### Maths Home Learning

At Ernulf Academy, we believe that home learning is an essential consolidation task necessary for all pupils to retain knowledge taught in the classrooms.

This letter explains the Mathematics home learning systems for all year groups. Mathematics home learning entails two elements:

1. **Online home learning task** on the following platforms:
  - a. Year 7
    - i. Half Term 1: Times Table Rockstars (TTRS)
    - ii. Half Term 2 to Half Term 6: TTRS and Sparx Maths
  - b. Year 8 and Year 9
    - i. Half Term 1: Times Table Rockstars (TTRS)
    - ii. Half Term 2 to Half Term 6: TTRS and Hegarty Maths
  - c. Year 10 and Year 11
    - i. Half Term 1 to Half Term 6: Hegarty Maths
2. **Paper and Pen home learning quizzes.** A weekly home learning quiz completed using pen and paper. This is a mock test in preparation for our in-class weekly quiz where the score is recorded on a teacher marksheet.

For clarity, online home learning will be submitted and due in the same day the following week. For example, Year 7 will have TTRS home learning set online on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September and it must be completed by the following Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> September.

The home learning quiz will be set and due in the next day. For example, Year 7 will have their home learning quiz given to them on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September and the submission day is next day – Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> September. In summary:

1. Online home learning: pupils submit their home learning after a week from the set date.
2. Quiz home learning: pupils submit their home learning the next day.

Here is a summary of the dates that home learning is set, and when the home learning is due:
