Guidance on completing homework using your Knowledge Organiser

- Use your knowledge organiser to help you compete 2 subjects per night (a double page of your homework book)
- <u>Avoid copying</u> from the KO. Instead....using the knowledge organiser, read, cover, retrieve key information and then check your answers.
- <u>**Really important</u></u>.....Add any missed information in a different colour pen to show where the gaps in your knowledge are.</u>**
- In morning registration you will be expected to have your KO and homework book on your desk and open – tutors will check – and note non-completion / missing equipment (C2 detention).





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


Cornell System
